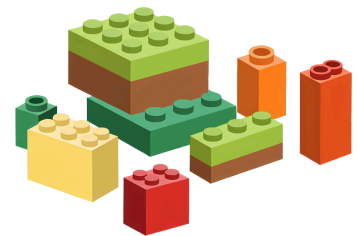

Dash needs some legs! Create and attach a leg out of Building Bricks and hit the ball into the soccer goal.

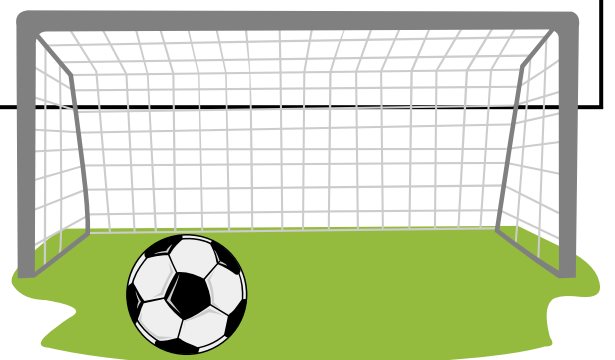

- Soccer Stadium template

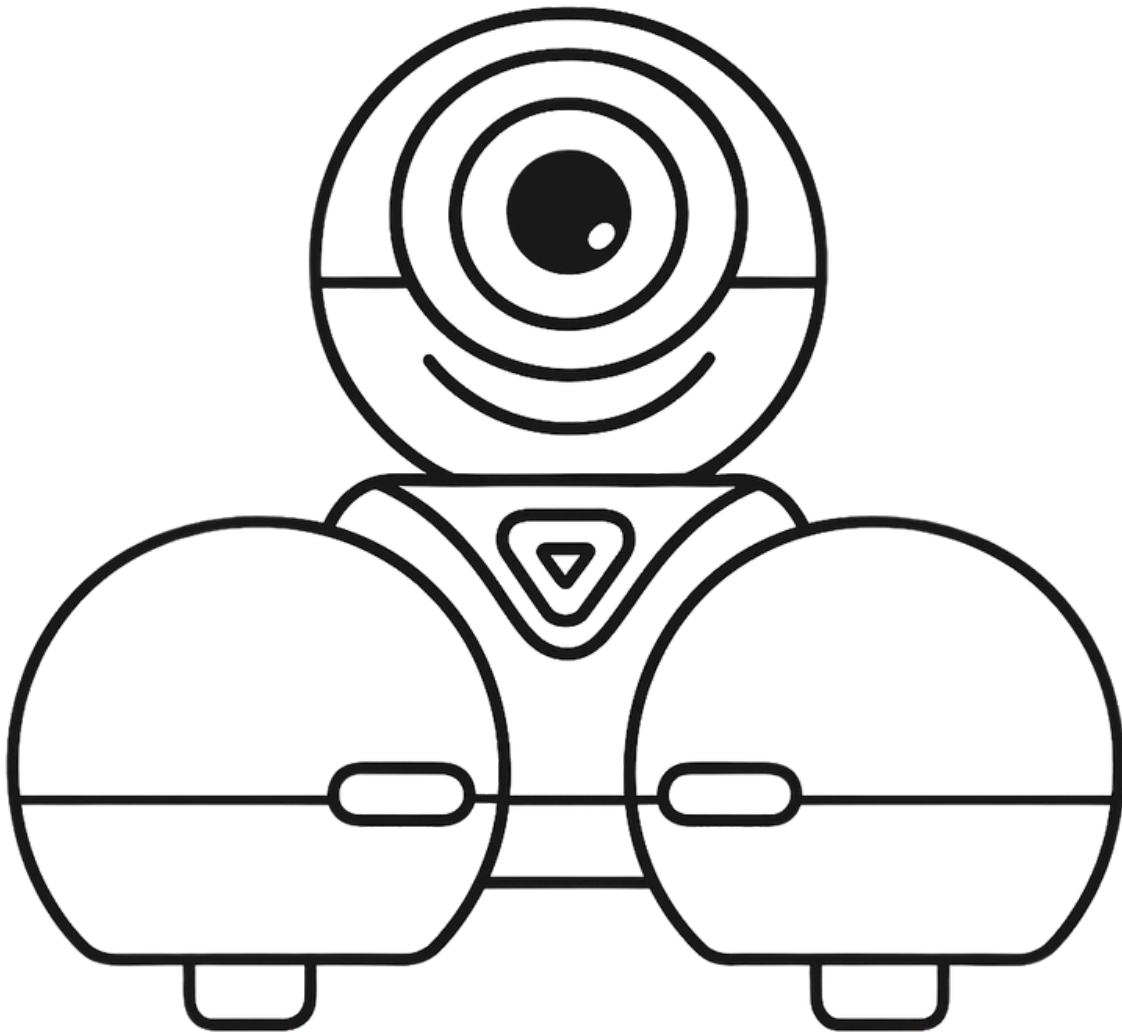


## You've Successfully Completed the Mission If You:

- Write a program that enables the robot to hit the ball into the goal with control.

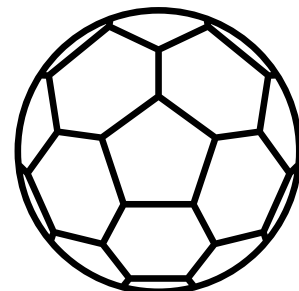

2. Click on 'Posters', then sizes. Choose your size.



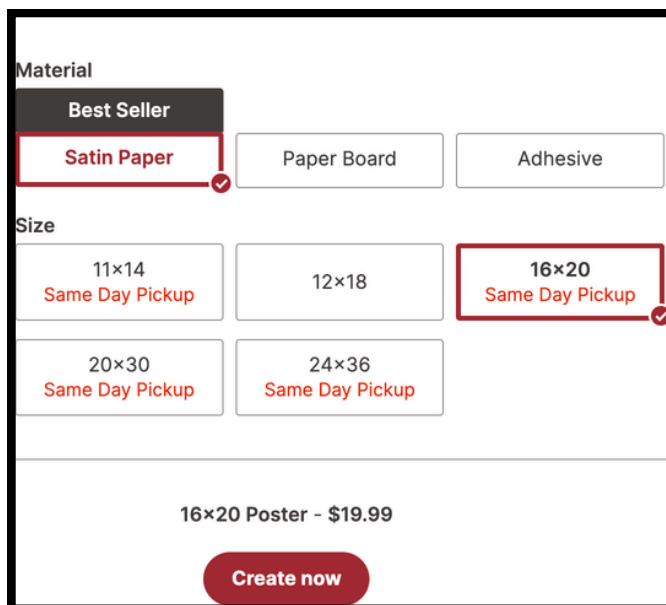

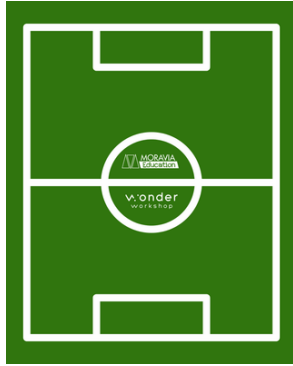

4. Download the matching size soccer field template & upload into your Walgreen's project.



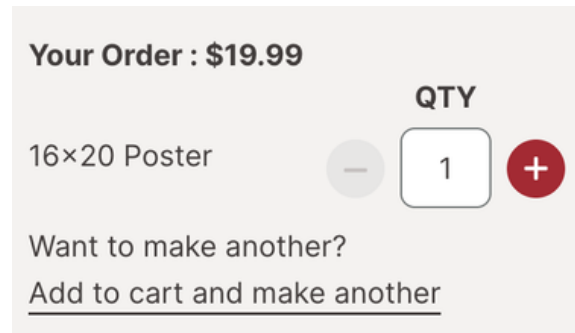
5. Our template is sized perfectly for you, so there isn't anything you will need to do in the Walgreen's project editor.
